- To provide a platform for exchanging ideas, opinions, arguments and sharing experiences,
- To promote networking among civil society activists and researchers in the region,
- To strengthen activism- and policy-oriented research in the field of climate, energy and environment geared towards sustainable solutions

Who can apply?

Members and employees of NGOs/CSOs, junior professionals, senior students and researchers working with NGOs/CSOs, and environment and climate activists.

Required qualifications of the participants

- To be active in the field of climate, energy and environment,
- At least two years of work or research experience in the field of climate, energy and environment,
- Good command of written and spoken English language,
- Resident of Egypt, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Palestine, Syria, or Turkey,
- Age between 20 and 35

- Motivation letter, in which the applicant explains how his/her work or research will benefit from the outcomes of the summer school (not more than one page and in English language).
